# The Bob Chivers Prize in Physical Acoustics

**FIRST PRIZE: £250 and award certificate**

The prize will be awarded every year to the best published paper covering PhD research in physical acoustics (including, but not limited to, fields such as ultrasonics, NDE, seismic waves, sonar, room acoustics).

The winner will be chosen by a review panel nominated by the group's committee.

**The paper:**

- Must be authored or co-authored by the winner who must be or have been a PhD student at a UK or Irish institution at the time of submission
- Must have been published in any peer-reviewed journal, but is limited to physical acoustics
- Must be publicly accessible (in electronic form or on paper) by 31 March of the year of the award
- Nominations are to be sent to the address given below
- Nominations to be received by the closing date of 31 May of the year of the award (earlier submissions at any time before the closing date are encouraged)
- The award will be presented at the Anglo French Physical Acoustics Conference AFPAC (usually held in January)
- With multi-authored papers please include a letter from the project supervisor stating that the work in the paper was mainly or exclusively undertaken by the applicant

**The next prize will be awarded at the Anglo French Physical Acoustics Conference 2019.**

- For consideration in this round, papers must have been accepted for publication and first appeared in the public domain in the period between 1 April 2016 and 31 March 2018
