Long-term nuclear waste management: next steps?

6–7 November 2006

Loughborough University

The Committee on Radioactive Waste Management (CoRWM) made their recommendations on long-term UK nuclear waste management public in July 2006. However, they did not cover all the scientific issues that need to be addressed to take the recommendations forward. There is a consensus amongst the learned and professional societies on the need for a multi-disciplinary problem lead approach to addressing the recommendations made by CoRWM. This 2-day meeting on 6–7th November 2006 at Loughborough conference centre will bring together the various disciplines involved in nuclear waste management to rigorously debate the scientific certainties and uncertainties surrounding future nuclear waste management issues, and to agree actionable recommendations.

The workshop and conference sessions will comprise of a series of problem focussed sessions in which invited speakers or an expert panel will provide an overview of the area to be followed by a scientific and managed debate.

Fees
